

K-6 CREATIVE ARTS SYMPOSIUM

WHAT IS THE COURSE ABOUT?

This two day symposium will explore the energising impact of the Creative Arts through a range of plenary and practical workshop sessions. Participants will be able to utilise the collaborative expertise of accomplished workshop facilitators to shape their learning experiences into stimulating classroom practice and to enrich school culture. Workshop choices will be available from the four Creative Arts strands to enable participants to tailor make the experience to suit their needs.

Workshops will include: visual arts, costuming and mask making, music percussion, adapting traditional stories for performance, drama in the classroom, and utilising the dance syllabus.

HOW WILL THE COURSE BE PRESENTED?

A range of plenary speakers and practical workshop sessions will provide current perspectives into best practice for incorporating the creative arts into the K-6 classroom. Participants will select workshops from the four strands of visual arts, music, drama and dance.

OUTCOMES OF THE COURSE:

As a result of participating in this course it is expected that teachers will gain:

- a greater appreciation and understanding of the creative arts as being central to innovative education practices in the primary school;
- strategies to use the creative arts to invigorate student learning and program planning;
- extended practical skills in applying syllabus concepts to the classroom;
- planning strategies to ensure scope and sequence in Creative Arts learning.
